RESOLUTION NO. 23-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLERSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, the safety of the residents of Millersburg Borough is the primary concern of Millersburg Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, recent heavy rains have caused local flooding, some building damage, and street damage in the form of a sink hole on Boyd Street next to the U.S. Post Office; and

WHEREAS, Millersburg Borough Council has deemed it essential that immediate emergency repairs to the sink hole and surrounding area as well as to the Borough Building roof, are necessary to ensure the health and safety of the public and employees of Millersburg Borough; and

WHEREAS, Millersburg Borough Council has consulted its Engineer and its Solicitor and has contacted PennDOT which considered the work on the street a continuation of a previous project, and the Council recognizes that the change of routes for truck deliveries to the U.S. Post Office and further delays in repairs are increasing the danger to the public and increasing costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Millersburg Borough Council declares an emergency for the purpose of approving safety repairs to the Borough Building roof and sink hole area on Boyd Street, waiving the need for additional quotes for repairs. This resolution is being adopted for the Borough records and to conform with the provision of Chapter 14 of the Borough Code.
