ORDINANCE NO. 3-23

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF NORTH STREET,
LOCATED IN DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Millersburg Borough Council of the Borough of Millersburg (the “Borough”) hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, there exists on the property of the Millersburg Area School District and Devon Schlegel Weaver and Robin Schlegel Young, an unopened portion of a street right-of-way located in the Township of Upper Paxton and the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the unopened portion of said street was laid out and has remained unopened for a period of time in excess of twenty-one years; and

WHEREAS, the Millersburg Area School District has submitted a Land Development Plan for a building expansion to house an elementary school; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of approval of said Land Development Plan, the Dauphin County Planning Commission has required that the unopened portion of the street right-of-way in the Township of Upper Paxton and the Borough be formally vacated by both municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owners adjacent to the affected portion of the unopened street right-of-way have been notified with regard to the proposed vacation of the unopened portion of street right-of-way, as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”, which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 1. Pursuant to the Borough Code, the Borough may by ordinance vacate any highway or road, or portion thereof, within its municipal boundaries.

Section 2. The Borough Council of the Borough of Millersburg hereby vacates the unopened portion of street right-of-way in the Borough, as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”, having found that such street right-of-way has been unopened and not used by the traveling public, and such portion is no longer necessary or required to serve the citizens of the Borough.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective after enactment.
