Solicitor Kerwin gave a brief overview of the issue at hand, a drag show event to be hosted by Peace of Mind Café, in the Borough.

Josh Eggleston

President Dietz led the Pledge of Allegiance and called for a brief moment of silence.

Borough Manager James Whitall reviewed the rules for anyone who wished to speak as well as for those who joined the meeting virtually.

President Dietz opened the floor for the public comment, as per the specified order.

Pastor Steve Blayer and Robin Stoner spoke on behalf of the petition signers, reportedly 653. The petition asked for Borough Council to enforce an age restriction, require visual barriers to be set up inside the establishment and to enforce Borough Code of Ordinances Chapter 6, Section 305, including obtaining an injunction.

Heather Holloway and Krystle Shearer spoke on behalf of the drag show organizers. The event was organized as a fundraiser for Pride in the Valley's 2024 festival. The age limit for this show has been raised from 14 to 18. The show is planned as a PG performance, containing nothing sexually overt.

Twenty-three individual speakers followed and the public comment portion of the meeting ended at 7:11PM.

Council discussion began. Motion by Councilman Boyer, seconded by Councilman Hoffman to require Peace of Mind to obscure the windows during the performance or to find them in violation of Borough Ordinance Chapter 6, Section 302. A roll call vote was held:

President Dietz announced that the motion failed.

Motion to adjourn by Councilman Boyer, seconded by Councilman Hoke. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 7:45PM.
