

**Millersburg Borough Committee of the Whole
Council Chambers
July 24, 2024 Meeting Minutes**

Call to Order – President Dietz called the meeting to order at 20:00 with Cl’ms Boyer, Hoy, Hoke, Campisi and Snyder present. Mayor Bowman, Junior Councilperson Vandewalle, and Borough Manager Whitall were also present.

Employee Relations

Employee Pool Party - Cl’m Campisi presented an idea about having an employee pool party. Looking at dates now, will likely take place during the work day.

Streets

2024 Paving Project – Tabled until August.

Lebo St. Curb – Manager Whitall presented a flooding issue affecting residents at Church and Lebo Sts. Stormwater runoff is causing flooding on front porches of disabled residents. Manager Whitall proposed a curb and larger storm water basin to try and mitigate runoff. Council discussed tackling the project in house.

Disability Signs – Cl’m Hoy presented her request for signs designating a disabled child lives in a certain area. Council requested additional information on how signs are deployed and managed in other municipalities. Manager Whitall to reach out to Gratz Borough.

Parks

Community Cleanup Day – Manager Whitall presented a suggestion for a Borough hosted Community Clean-up day in partnership with local organizations and the Dauphin County Beautification Committee. Council advised him to start planning the event separate from the Spring Recycling event.

Market Square Park Update – Cl’m provided a brief update on the project. The architect had reached out to finalize some finer details. Design is about 50% completed.
