ORDINANCE NO. 5-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 5-22, HOUSEHOLD BIRD ORDINANCE, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLD BIRDS THAT MAY BE KEPT ON A PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the cost of food, including eggs, has risen significantly due to inflation, supply chain disruptions, and other economic factors, making backyard chicken keeping a practical way for residents to supplement their household food supply; and

WHEREAS, allowing residents to keep backyard chickens aligns with sustainability goals by promoting local food production and reducing reliance on commercial egg suppliers; and

WHEREAS, Millersburg Borough is a Sustainable PA Bronze Certified Community, committed to fostering environmentally responsible practices and encouraging self-sufficiency among residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Millersburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 5-22 is amended as follows:

- Section 2.a Limit on Number of Household Birds:
 - The maximum number of household birds on a qualifying property shall be twelve (12), an increase from the previously established limit of nine (9).

All other provisions of Borough Ordinance No. 5-22 shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
