Millersburg Borough Committee of the Whole Council Chambers May 28, 2025 Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order</u> – Vice President Boyer called the meeting to order at 8:39pm with Cl'ms Hoke, Snyder, Hoffman, and Hoy present. Mayor Bowman, and Borough Manager Whitall were also present.

Employee Relations

Nothing to discuss.

Economic Development

<u>America250 Celebration</u> – No update.

Streets

<u>Tanner's Run</u> – Manager Whitall reviewed the updated Tanner's Run Study which now includes remedies and cost estimates. He stated that another stakeholder meeting should be called to discuss next steps. Cl'm Hoffman stated that his meeting with Commissioner Pries went well and that Senator Rothman was scheduled to visit in July with Representative Kerwin. Cl'm Campisi stated that she was working on getting Commissioner Douglas up to visit.

Golf Cart Ordinance – Cl'm Hoffman presented an ordinance to allow golf carts to operate on Borough streets, citing increased access to the business district from the river. Multiple requests have come to the Borough office from campers across the river on the policy for golf carts. The unofficial policy to date has been that they may not cross state highways. Discussion amongst Council members centered around keeping carts off of the walking path at Riverfront and ensuring the whole town would benefit from the ordinance. Manager Whitall was asked to edit the ordinance and return it for further discussion.

Parks

<u>Market Square Park Update</u> – Manager Whitall provided an update on sponsorships. A cutoff date for bricks will need to be looked at to ensure they are placed in the walking path prior to project completion. Council discussed a sponsorship plaque for donations under \$150, but no determination was made on placement or design.

<u>MYP Park Campground</u> - Cl'm Hoke proposed creating a Campground in the southern portion of MYO park that would allow for the storage of campers and potentially tent sites. He indicated that this could be a potential revenue stream for the Borough.

Property

Daniel Miller House – No update.

Public Safety

<u>Nuisance Ordinance</u> – Manager Whitall presented Nuisance Ordinance verbiage to address properties from which noxious odor complaints had originated. Council suggested that this would fit under the current Nuisance Ordinance and would clarify language. Cl'm Boyer to discuss with the Police Department.

<u>Police Candidate</u> – Cl'm Hoke stated that he knows of a local candidate that was interested in being a Police Officer. Council discussed the current department and potential for growth. Discussion tabled until closer to budget time.

Cl'm Campisi called in to the meeting at 9:26pm.

<u>Millersburg Pool</u> – Cl'm Campisi provided an update on operations at the Pool. As the pool board attempted to open this year, they found that corners were cut and routine maintenance had not been completed properly, causing more damage and cost in upkeep. The Pool will be coming to the Borough for financial assistance.
