



Mayoral Proclamation

Declaring a Snow Emergency in Millersburg Borough

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service has forecast a severe winter storm expected to impact the Millersburg Borough area, bringing significant snowfall and hazardous travel conditions; and

WHEREAS, such conditions pose a threat to public safety and impede emergency services, snow removal operations, and general travel; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to ensure that Borough streets, particularly designated snow emergency routes, remain clear to allow for effective snow plowing, salting, and emergency response;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Alan Bowman, the Mayor of the Borough of Millersburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority granted under the Millersburg Borough Code, do hereby declare a Snow Emergency within the Borough of Millersburg.

1. Effective Period

This Snow Emergency shall be in effect beginning Saturday, January 24, at 8:00 PM, and shall remain in effect until Tuesday, January 27, at 8:00 AM, unless terminated earlier by official action.

2. Parking Restrictions

Pursuant to Millersburg Borough Code Section 15-701, it shall be unlawful at any time during the continuance of this Snow Emergency for any person to park a motor vehicle, or permit a motor vehicle to remain parked, anywhere on any designated Snow Emergency Route.

3. Designated Snow Emergency Routes

As amended by Ordinance 1-11, the designated Snow Emergency Routes within the Borough include:

Center Street – both sides from Market Street to Church Street

Center Street – north side from Seal Street to SR 25

Market Square

Market Street from the American Legion to Pine Street

North Street from Market Street to Seal Street

Union Street from Market Square to Church Street

Church Street from Union Street to Oak Street

4. Enforcement

Any vehicle found in violation of this declaration may be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense, in accordance with Borough ordinances and applicable law.

5. Public Notice

Residents and property owners are encouraged to monitor official Borough communications for updates and to cooperate fully to ensure public safety and efficient snow removal operations.
