**RESOLUTION NO. 19-15**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLERSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL, DAUPHIN  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF SB 607**

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is the only state in the country that does not allow local police to use radar technologies to enforce speed limits; and

**WHEREAS**, Millersburg Borough operates a police department; and

**WHEREAS**, a January, 2019 speed study on the 300 block of Market Street (SR 147) indicated that the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed was 32 MPH in a 25 MPH zone and several vehicles were shown to be traveling at as much as 55 MPH during daylight hours; and

**WHEREAS**, the speed study was conducted in a business district and clearly indicates a safety concern; and

**WHEREAS**, the Millersburg Borough Council believes that allowing local police to utilize Radar technologies to enforce speed limits will help to lower average speeds on local and state highways within its jurisdiction, thus improving traffic and pedestrian safety;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Millersburg Borough Council expresses its support of Senate Bill 607 and the policies contained therein.


